

Enough is Enough: Rally to Protest the UN's Demonization of Israel

According to recently published documents, the UN Human Rights Council is planning an unprecedented assault on Israel at its upcoming main annual session.

Over the entire day of Monday, March 18, 2019, Israel will be targeted with seven specious reports, more than ever before. The UNHRC will release the report of their Commission of Inquiry into Israel's "large-scale assault" on "civilian" Palestinian protesters at the Gaza border; a report on their Blacklist of companies who do business over the Green Line, a thinly veiled form of anti-Israel BDS; and a report calling to implement the anti-Israel findings of the 2009 Goldstone Report, even though this was later renounced by Judge Goldstone himself. And there will be four more—on alleged Israeli crimes in the Golan, the territories, the settlements and so on.

Enough is enough. On this Black Monday of March 18th, it is time for us to cry out against the UN's relentless and pathological persecution of the Jewish nation, which violates the fundamental equality principles of the United Nations Charter.

Therefore, UN Watch is organizing a major international protest rally in Geneva, in the public square facing the UNHRC, on Monday, March 18, 2019, at 12:30 pm. The event will be broadcast live around the world. We are inviting eminent speakers including Members of Parliament from across Europe. We will be supported by an array of Jewish and pro-Israel organizations in Switzerland and worldwide.
